

WEST NOTTINGHAM TOWNSHIP
Public Hearing and Special Meeting
For the Oxford Region Planning Committee Multi-Municipal
Comprehensive Plan Amendment for East Nottingham Township to Rejoin the ORPC
August 24, 2016

The following were in attendance: Charles Wilmont, Eric Todd, David Ross, Candace Miller, Mark Gallant, and Winnie Sebastian (Solicitor for ORPC).

CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Wilmont, Vice-Chairman, called the hearing to order at 7:21 p.m. He immediately recessed the hearing and opened the special meeting. He recessed the special meeting and reopened the hearing for the presentation of exhibits and public comment.

PRESENTATION

Mr. Gallant gave a brief overview of the Multi-Municipal Comprehensive Plan and summarized the amendment changes made in 2014 and the proposed changes to the new ordinance for East Nottingham Township to rejoin the Committee.

He explained the ordinance and implementation agreement. He pointed out that the committee is not a regular planning committee, but rather a committee to provide guidance. Municipal zoning is still in place. He talked about the responsibility of the group to include the annual contribution for legal fees. He said that the role is to ensure that changes that have a regional impact follow agreed upon guidelines.

Ms. Sebastian reviewed the exhibits including the proof of publication, ordinance and implementation agreement. She noted that under Pennsylvania law, municipalities can enter into an agreement via an ordinance.

The hearing was adjourned at 7:38 p.m. Mr. Wilmont reconvened the special meeting at 7:38 p.m.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

BUSINESS

Mr. Todd moved to adopt the amended Intergovernmental Cooperative Implementation Agreement Ordinance, number 1-2016. Mr. Wilmont seconded the motion. Motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT

Mr. Wilmont adjourned the special meeting at 7:39 p.m.
