Monday, December 21, 2020

BUSINESS

Goat Hill Barrens: There was concern about people living in the parking lot of the Goat Hill Serpentine Barrens off Red Pump Road. Neighbors to the Goat Hill Serpentine Barrens reported loud noises, yelling, cussing, and drug use by homeless individuals parking over night in the parking lot. Mr. Wacker from DCNR said that over night camping is not allowed without a permit and that no permits have been issued to date. He agreed to work with Chief McFadden on the matter and provided contact information.

USDA Grant Discussion: There was discussion about a USDA Grant/Loan opportunity. Pauline Garcia-Allen attended the meeting to discuss the options and provide some guidance. She suggested the Township prioritize their wants and then begin from there.
